- 1. **build up** (phrasal verb) strengthen, increase/raise, intensify, enhance.
- 2. **wake up to** (phrasal verb) realize, become aware of, become heedful of.
- 3. **figure out** (phrasal verb) understand, comprehend, work out, find an answer/solution to.
- 4. **shore up** (phrasal verb) support, assist, prop up.
- 5. **stave off** (phrasal verb) avert, prevent, avoid, rule out.
- 6. dawn on (phrasal verb) if something (an idea or fact) dawns on you, you begin to understand it for the first time; come to mind, strike, be perceived, be realized.
- 7. **bring out** (phrasal verb) disclose, reveal, expose, become known.
- 8. **come along** (phrasal verb) progress, make progress, develop.
- 9. **spring from** (phrasal verb) originate from, arise from, stem from, emanate from, evolve from, come from.
- 10. **come up with** (phrasal verb) produce, put forward, present/submit.
- 11. **wipe out** (phrasal verb) remove, get rid of, dispose of.
- 12. **go by** (phrasal verb) (of time/year) to pass.
- 13. **do away with** (phrasal verb) abolish, discard, remove.
- 14. **go beyond** (phrasal verb) to go past something, exceed, surpass.
- 15. **rely on** (phrasal verb) depend on; resort to, have recourse to.
- 16. **carry out** (phrasal verb) conduct, perform, execute.
- 17. **eat out** (phrasal verb) dine out, go to the restaurant; have meal in restaurant.
- 18. **boil down to** (phrasal verb) come down to, amount to, comprise (as the main or central part).
- 19. **wean from** (phrasal verb) to make somebody gradually stop using something.

- 20. pin on (phrasal verb) attribute the blame/responsibility for something to someone.
- 21. **square with** (phrasal verb) agree, tally, be in agreement, be consistent, coincide.
- 22. ward off (phrasal verb) prevent, oppose, avert, resist.
- 23. lag behind (phrasal verb) trail, fall back, straggle/move slowly.
- 24. **flag off** (phrasal verb) signal, give a sign to, indicate.
- 25. **shoot down** (phrasal verb) gun down, hit with a bullet/missile.
- 26. cave in (phrasal verb) collapse, fall down, crumble, disintegrate.
- 27. **strike at** (phrasal verb) to cause damage to someone/something; to have a serious effect on somebody/something; affect, afflict.
- 28. **hold out** (phrasal verb) offer, present (a hope, possibility, opportunity, etc.); have a feeling of (hope).
- 29. draw up (phrasal verb) formulate, create, work out.
- 30. **spell out** (phrasal verb) explain, make clear, elucidate/clarify.
- 31. **set aside** (phrasal verb) earmark, withhold; save, reserve, put aside.
- 32. **strike out** (phrasal verb) be unsuccessful, fail.
- 33. **stand for** (phrasal verb) be a candidate in an election.
- 34. **stamp out** (phrasal verb) to stop, to put an end to, to get rid of something.
- 35. **let off** (phrasal verb) release, discharge, acquit.
- 36. turn down (phrasal verb) reject, refuse, decline, say no to.
- 37. **strike down** (phrasal verb) abolish, annul, nullify (a law or regulation).
- 38. **take away** (phrasal verb) remove, take out, deprive, divest, strip.
- 39. take up (phrasal verb) become involved in, engage in, take part in; accept, say yes to, agree to.

- 40. **set about** (phrasal verb) begin, start, undertake, embark on.
- 41. **come up** (phrasal verb) occur or present itself.
- 42. **take on** (phrasal verb) compete against, oppose, challenge, confront.
- 43. **live up to** (phrasal verb) satisfy, fulfil, achieve, meet.
- 44. **account for** (phrasal verb) constitute, comprise, represent.
- 45. **bring in** (phrasal verb) introduce, cause, bring about, create.
- 46. **bring back** (phrasal verb) cause something to return to; reintroduce.
- 47. **point out** (phrasal verb) identify, mention, indicate, draw attention to.
- 48. **shut down** (phrasal verb) discontinue, cease activity, close.
- 49. **speak of** (phrasal verb) mention, talk about, discuss, refer to, remark on, comment on.
- 50. **put up** (phrasal verb) display, propose.
- 51. **push back** (phrasal verb) force back, repel, fight off.
- 52. **live by** (phrasal verb) behave (as stated by beliefs or principles).
- 53. **end up** (phrasal verb) come/appear, find oneself (to a particular course of action in the end).
- 54. **go after** (phrasal verb) take actions to criticize/punish someone.
- 55. **go on to** (phrasal verb) continue, proceed (to do something).
- 56. **leave behind** (phrasal verb) to leave a trace of something.
- 57. move away from (phrasal verb) change/alter one's ideas/beliefs/views and so.
- 58. **put in** (phrasal verb) dedicate time/effort to something.
- 59. **step up** (phrasal verb) increase, intensify, strengthen, augment, escalate, scale up.
- 60. **lay down** (phrasal verb) formulate, establish, institute, enforce.
- 61. **go ahead** (phrasal verb) to proceed, to continue to do something, to start/begin to do something.
- 62. **gear up** (phrasal verb) get ready, prepare, equip (oneself) for something.

- 63. **snuff out** (phrasal verb) kill (in a sudden manner).
- 64. **drop out** (phrasal verb) withdraw, give up, discontinue.
- 65. **fall through** (phrasal verb) fail.
- 66. **reckon with** (phrasal verb) consider, take into account, take into consideration.
- 67. **whip up** (phrasal verb) arouse, trigger, prompt, induce.
- 68. **verge on** (phrasal verb) incline towards, border on, approach, come near, be close to.
- 69. **thrash out** (phrasal verb) resolve, settle, sort out, deal with, handle.
- 70. **shake off** (phrasal verb) get rid of, give up, abandon, end (a feeling).
- 71. **cut off** (phrasal verb) block/stop, remove, discontinue (a standard method of doing/accessing something).
- 72. blow up (phrasal verb) destroy, demolish, knock down (as by explosion); explode, detonate.
- 73. **stand out** (phrasal verb) be noticeable, be visible, be obvious.
- 74. **lie off** (phrasal verb) be placed some distance from coast/shore.
- 75. **pull in** (phrasal verb) succeed in obtaining something.
- 76. **roll out** (phrasal verb) launch, introduce, organize, inaugurate (something officially).
- 77. **turn up** (phrasal verb) arrive, come, go, be present, attend.
- 78. **set in** (phrasal verb) (of something unpleasant) begin, start, develop gradually.
- 79. **take down** (phrasal verb) remove, dismantle, demolish.
- 80. **bring about** (phrasal verb) cause, produce, give rise to.
- 81. **lock out** (phrasal verb) exclude/remove someone from.
- 82. **step down** (phrasal verb) give up, stand down, abdicate, renounce.
- 83. warm up (phrasal verb) prepare, get ready, get into condition.
- 84. **reflect on** (phrasal verb) to affect other people's opinion of someone, particularly in a bad/poor way.

- 85. **opt out** (phrasal verb) decide not to participate in something.
- 86. **hand over** (phrasal verb) pass, transfer, assign.
- 87. **stay away from** (phrasal verb) avoid, evade, dodge.
- 88. **step in** (phrasal verb) intervene, become involved, get involved, take action.
- 89. make up (phrasal verb) comprise, form, compose, constitute.
- 90. **move forward** (phrasal verb) progress, make progress, advance, develop.
- 91. **call for** (phrasal verb) require, publicly ask/necessitate, demand.
- 92. **see through** (phrasal verb) realize, understand, get the measure of.
- 93. **open up** (phrasal verb) create (a new opportunity or possibility).
- 94. **set up** (phrasal verb) establish, start/begin, inaugurate, create.
- 95. **carry on** (phrasal verb) continue, proceed, progress, keep going, get going.
- 96. **lead up to** (phrasal verb) come before a particular event.
- 97. **keep away** from (phrasal verb) make someone stay away from.
- 98. make out (phrasal verb) portray, represent, assert.
- 99. harp on (phrasal verb) talk or write/complain continuously and lengthy on a particular subject.
- 100. **hole up** (phrasal verb) hide out, conceal oneself, shelter.
- 101. **play down** (phrasal verb) downplay, understate, de-emphasize, gloss over, minimize, shrug off.
- 102. go down with (phrasal verb) fall ill with, get, contract, fall victim to, become infected with.
- 103. **crack down on** (phrasal verb) get tough on, take severe measures against, clamp down on.
- 104. **cast on/upon** (phrasal verb) to cause to fall onto or over something.
- 105. **draw out** (phrasal verb) prolong, extend, protract, stretch out, lengthen.
- 106. build on (phrasal verb) to use something as a base to achieve more development/success, expand on, develop, enhance.

- 107. **step back** (phrasal verb) withdraw, disengage, pull out/pull back.
- 108. **put off** (phrasal verb) postpone, delay, defer, hold off.
- 109. break out (phrasal verb) flare up, begin/start suddenly, erupt, set in.
- 110. **put down** (phrasal verb) suppress, put an end to, crush, quash, quell, overthrow.
- 111. **run through** (phrasal verb) be present in, pass through, imbue, go through.
- 112. **put out** (phrasal verb) issue, publish, release, make public, publicize.
- 113. **pull out** (phrasal verb) withdraw, retreat, get/move out.
- 114. **result in** (phrasal verb) cause, bring on, bring about, call forth, give rise to.
- 115. lie ahead (phrasal verb) be going to happen.
- 116. scale up (phrasal verb) increase, augment; step up.
- 117. line up (phrasal verb) form a queue, queue up, form lines.
- 118. **give up** (phrasal verb) stop, discontinue, abandon, renounce, forgo.
- 119. take back (phrasal verb) get back, regain, repossess, reclaim, retrieve, recover.
- 120. pull back (phrasal verb) withdraw, retreat, disengage.
- 121. **get past** (phrasal verb) to move past (an obstacle); overcome.
- 122. turn into (phrasal verb) transform into; cause to become (a particular kind of person/thing).
- 123. bring down (phrasal verb) reduce, decrease, lessen.
- 124. turn out (phrasal verb) produce something.
- 125. lock up (phrasal verb) imprison, jail, incarcerate, detain, confine.
- 126. leave aside (phrasal verb) to not consider something; ignore, dismiss, push aside.
- 127. **come out** (phrasal verb) become known, come to light, emerge, transpire.
- 128. break down (phrasal verb) fail, collapse, founder, fall through, be unsuccessful, disintegrate.
- 129. break up (phrasal verb) disperse, scatter, disband, separate; destroy.

- 130. scale back (phrasal verb) reduce (in size/number/extent).
- 131. **go about** (phrasal verb) begin, start, undertake, embark on, get to work on.
- 132. **bail out** (phrasal verb) obtain the release (on payment of bail).
- 133. **go through** (phrasal verb) undergo, experience, be subjected to, live through.
- 134. mark out (phrasal verb) define, describe, outline.
- 135. cry (out) for (phrasal verb) require, demand, need, necessitate, call for.
- 136. wean away from (phrasal verb) to detach, disconnect, separate someone from depending on something.
- 137. **take off** (phrasal verb) succeed, do well, progress, turn out well, work out.
- 138. **phase out** (phrasal verb) eliminate, remove, discontinue, get rid of (something in gradual stages).
- 139. **creep upon** (phrasal verb) inch, crawl, tiptoe, move slowly & stealthily.
- 140. **choke off** (phrasal verb) block, obstruct, stop, bring to an end, stifle.
- 141. weigh in (phrasal verb) to have influence (in a decision/discussion/plan/argument/activity); be important to, carry weight, make an impression on, make a contribution to.
- 142. mow down (phrasal verb) knock down (with a vehicle).
- 143. seek out (phrasal verb) to keep searching for someone or something until you find out them; search out, look around.
- 144. **run out** (phrasal verb) have none left, have no more of, be out of; use up, be exhausted, be finished.
- 145. **hit out at** (phrasal verb) criticize, attack, denounce, lash out at, condemn, censure.
- 146. **pump into** (phrasal verb) invest a lot of money in something.
- 147. slow down (phrasal verb) reduce, lessen decrease (one's activity).
- 148. pick up (phrasal verb) improve, get better, recover, rally.
- 149. **fall back on** (phrasal verb) have recourse to, rely on, make use of, utilize.
- 150. swear in (phrasal verb) admit into office, inaugurate, introduce (into office).

- 151. act on (phrasal verb) comply with, act in accordance with, follow, take action according to.
- 152. **push through** (phrasal verb) to make a plan to put something into use as quickly as possible.
- 153. **try out** (phrasal verb) test, trial, experiment.
- 154. **rule out** (phrasal verb) eliminate, reject, dismiss.
- 155. **build in** (phrasal verb) incorporate, include, embody.
- 156. **stem from** (phrasal verb) originate from, arise/come from, emanate from.
