## A PHRASAL VERBS (01-31MAR21)

- 1. **phase out** (phrasal verb) provide/eliminate (something in gradual stages).
- 2. **rule out** (phrasal verb) eliminate, reject, dismiss.
- 3. **run out** (phrasal verb) exhaust, finish, use up, come to an end, end; be out of.
- 4. **wear out** (phrasal verb) deteriorate, become worn, come to the end of its life, become useless.
- 5. **take up** (phrasal verb) accept, say yes to, agree to, accede to, adopt; engage in, become involved in.
- ward off (phrasal verb) prevent, oppose, avert, resist.
- 7. **turn down** (phrasal verb) reject, refuse, decline, say no to.
- 8. **narrow down** (phrasal verb) reduce, lessen, decrease.
- 9. **take down** (phrasal verb) remove, dismantle, demolish.
- 10. **speak out** (phrasal verb) express, articulate, communicate, convey, voice (something straightforwardly & publicly).
- 11. **step aside** (phrasal verb) leave, quit, withdraw, resign.
- 12. **serve out** (phrasal verb) to complete, finish, end (a term in prison, office, etc.).
- 13. **make up for** (phrasal verb) atone for, make amends for, compensate for, make recompense for, make reparation for, make redress for.
- 14. **bail out** (phrasal verb) provide financial help/support to a person who faces serious financial difficulty.
- 15. **figure out** (phrasal verb) understand, comprehend, work out, find an answer/solution to.
- 16. **reach out** (phrasal verb) contact someone to obtain/offer help/assistance/cooperation.
- 17. **mete out** (phrasal verb) dispense, give out, hand out (a punishment).
- 18. **lay out** (phrasal verb) outline, frame, draft, draw up, formulate.
- 19. **move away from** (phrasal verb) change/alter one's ideas/beliefs/views and so.
- 20. **crack down on** (phrasal verb) get tough on, take severe measures against, clamp down on.
- 21. **stick to** (phrasal verb) abide by, hold to, comply with, fulfil, make good.
- 22. **push back** (phrasal verb) force back, repel, fight off.
- 23. **prevail over** (phrasal verb) succeed, triumph, be victorious, gain mastery, prove superior.
- 24. **box in** (phrasal verb) confine, restrain, constrain, trap, fence in, hem in.
- 25. **end up** (phrasal verb) come/appear, find oneself (to a particular course of action in the end).

- 26. **set up** (phrasal verb) establish, start/begin, inaugurate, create.
- 27. **look for** (phrasal verb) search for, try to find, hope to obtain something.
- 28. **embark on** (phrasal verb) start, begin initiate/commence.
- 29. **step up** (phrasal verb) increase, intensify, strengthen, augment.
- 30. **push ahead** (phrasal verb) continue, proceed with (a plan of action).
- 31. **bring back** (phrasal verb) cause someone/something to return to; reintroduce.
- 32. **scale down** (phrasal verb) reduce, lower, decrease.
- 33. **pull out** (phrasal verb) withdraw, retreat, get/move out.
- 34. **throw up** (phrasal verb) produce something.
- 35. **lay down** (phrasal verb) formulate, insist on, establish, determine.
- 36. **break down** (phrasal verb) fail, collapse, founder, fall through, be unsuccessful, disintegrate.
- 37. **turn up** (phrasal verb) arrive, come, go, be present, attend.
- 38. **find out** (phrasal verb) notice, note, come to know, get to know.
- 39. **result in** (phrasal verb) cause, bring on, bring about, call forth, give rise to.
- 40. **hand over** (phrasal verb) pass, transfer, assign.
- 41. **shut down** (phrasal verb) cease activity, close down, cease operation.
- 42. **account for** (phrasal verb) constitute, comprise, form, represent.
- 43. **carry out** (phrasal verb) conduct, perform, implement, execute, bring about.
- 44. **set in** (phrasal verb) (of something unpleasant) begin, start, develop gradually.
- 45. **go by** (phrasal verb) follow, observe something.
- 46. **rope in** (phrasal verb) persuade, convince, urge (someone to take part in an activity).
- 47. **leave behind** (phrasal verb) to leave a trace of something.
- 48. **pass off** (phrasal verb) deceive, make up, pretend, misrepresent/misreport, falsify.
- 49. **clamp down on** (phrasal verb) prevent, stop, put an end to; keep under control.
- 50. **shrug aside/shrug off** (phrasal verb) dismiss, ignore, forget, disregard, set aside, pay no heed to.
- 51. **egg on** (phrasal verb) urge, incite, provoke, induce.
- 52. **whip up** (phrasal verb) arouse, trigger, prompt, induce.
- 53. **tide over** (phrasal verb) sustain; support, assist, aid (someone in difficulty with money, food, etc.).

- 54. **wash away** (phrasal verb) to remove, get rid of something completely.
- 55. **head off** (phrasal verb) divert, deflect, redirect, reroute, turn aside, turn away.
- 56. **chase down** (phrasal verb) run after and catch someone; follow and catch someone.
- 57. **see off** (phrasal verb) deal with, tackle, handle someone/something successfully; defeat, overcome, crush.
- 58. sweep up (phrasal verb) remove, clean, scrub, wipe.
- 59. **lock down** (phrasal verb) confine, restraint, enclose, encircle/hem in.
- 60. **lock in** (phrasal verb) to prevent someone from leaving a house (by locking the door).
- 61. **throw out** (phrasal verb) reject, dismiss, veto/refuse.
- 62. **brush aside** (phrasal verb) dismiss, disregard, ignore.
- 63. **throw open** (phrasal verb) make something accessible/attainable suddenly & fully.
- 64. **hark back** (phrasal verb) recall, remember, recollect, think of something from the past.
- 65. **call upon** (phrasal verb) demand, require, ask formally.
- 66. **distance oneself from** (phrasal verb) denounce, disown, reject, condemn, disagree with.
- 67. **push for** (phrasal verb) demand, insist on, ask for; support, advocate, recommend, champion.
- 68. **bear upon** (phrasal verb) be relevant to something.
- 69. **come up with** (phrasal verb) produce, put forward, present/submit.
- 70. **go on** (phrasal verb) happen, occur, take place.
- 71. **swear in** (phrasal verb) admit into office, inaugurate, introduce (into office).
- 72. **go through** (phrasal verb) search, look through; examine, study, scrutinize, inspect, read over, look at.
- 73. **go beyond** (phrasal verb) to go past something, exceed, surpass.
- 74. **turn around** (phrasal verb) change direction/course; reverse direction.
- 75. **scale up** (phrasal verb) increase, augment; step up.
- 76. take on (phrasal verb) face, challenge, confront.
- 77. **step out** (phrasal verb) leave a building/place for a short period of time.
- 78. **set to** (phrasal verb) start doing something aggressively.
- 79. **roll out** (phrasal verb) launch, introduce, organize, inaugurate (something officially).
- 80. **point out** (phrasal verb) identify, mention, indicate, draw attention to.
- 81. **bring about** (phrasal verb) cause, create, produce.
- 82. **work out** (phrasal verb) develop, form, initiate/establish.
- 83. **speed up** (phrasal verb) hurry up, accelerate, move faster, go faster.

- 84. **rely on** (phrasal verb) depend on; resort to, have recourse to.
- 85. **build on** (phrasal verb) develop, enhance, expand on.
- 86. **take through** (phrasal verb) explain, define, interpret, clarify.
- 87. **turn against** (phrasal verb) become hostile to, take a dislike to, cause to be unfriendly towards; oppose, go against, reject, object, stand against.
- 88. **give up on** (phrasal verb) stop having faith; stop having belief (in someone).
- 89. **dispense with** (phrasal verb) discard, get rid of, do away with; forgo, renounce.
- 90. **turn out** (phrasal verb) happen, develop, end (in a specific way).
- 91. **fade away** (phrasal verb) diminish, disappear, decline, dwindle.
- 92. **put up** (phrasal verb) display, present.
- 93. **bring up** (phrasal verb) raise something (a point/issue) for discussion.
- 94. **add to** (phrasal verb) increase, amplify, intensify.
- 95. **pick up** (phrasal verb) improve, get better, recover, rally.
- 96. play out (phrasal verb) happen, occur, take place.
- 97. **pull back** (phrasal verb) withdraw, retreat, disengage.
- 98. **take over** (phrasal verb) assume control of, take control of; seize, appropriate.
- 99. **set out** (phrasal verb) present, describe, set forth.
- 100. **chalk up** (phrasal verb) to think that a particular matter is caused by something. ascribe, attribute, connect/link with.
- 101. **stitch up** (phrasal verb) arrange, organize (a deal/agreement to someone's benefit).
- 102. **be shorn of** (phrasal verb) to have something important removed from you.
- 103. **bet on** (phrasal verb) to be certain/confident that something will take place.
- 104. **trickle down** (phrasal verb) pass on benefits to the people at the bottom of the pyramid (by those at top of the system).
- 105. **thrive on** (phrasal verb) to enjoy something, particularly one that other people find unpleasant; to be successful at something particularly one that other people find difficult.
- 106. **weigh in** (phrasal verb) to have influence (in a decision/discussion/plan/argument/activity); be important to, carry weight, make an impression on, make a strong contribution to.
- 107. **take forward** (phrasal verb) give one's attention to, deal/cope with, address, handle.
- 108. **reason with** (phrasal verb) talk round, win round, persuade, coax, prevail on, convince.
- 109. **throw in** (phrasal verb) add, include something (free).
- 110. **draw up** (phrasal verb) formulate, create, work out.
- 111. **hold on to** (phrasal verb) keep or retain something.

- 112. **edge out** (phrasal verb) remove an employee from a firm (indirectly).
- 113. **wake up** (to) (phrasal verb) realize, become aware of, become heedful of.
- 114. **kick in** (phrasal verb) come into operation, come into effect.
- 115. **gear up** (phrasal verb) get ready, prepare, equip (oneself) for something.
- 116. **pass through** (phrasal verb) go through, undergo, get through, traverse, pass over, infiltrate.
- 117. **see through** (phrasal verb) fathom, realize, understand.
- 118. **borne out** past participle of **bear out** (phrasal verb) confirm, validate, vindicate, justify/support (a claim).
- 119. **walk out** (phrasal verb) depart, get out, leave suddenly; desert, abandon.
- 120. **set off** (phrasal verb) give rise to, cause, trigger, prompt, bring about.
- 121. **step down** (phrasal verb) give up, stand down, abdicate, renounce.
- 122. look after (phrasal verb) take care of, care for, attend to.
- 123. **open up** (phrasal verb) become accessible; become available.
- 124. **rest on** (phrasal verb) be based on, depend on, be dependent on, rely on.
- 125. **call for** (phrasal verb) require, publicly ask/necessitate, demand.
- 126. take off (phrasal verb) remove, discard, shrug off.
- 127. turn away (phrasal verb) repel, reject, rebuff, send away.
- 128. **come in** (phrasal verb) enter, arrive, be involved, to take part in something.
- 129. **shoot down** (phrasal verb) gun down, hit with a bullet/missile.
- 130. **slow down** (phrasal verb) reduce, lessen decrease (one's activity).
- 131. **put together** (phrasal verb) organize, arrange, sort out.
- 132. **ramp up** (phrasal verb) increase (in amount or number).
- 133. **speak of** (phrasal verb) mention, talk about, discuss, refer to.
- 134. harp on (phrasal verb) talk or write/complain continuously and lengthy on a particular subject.
- 135. **get past** (phrasal verb) if something such as a proposal gets past someone, it is accepted by someone who has the power to stop it happening; able to overcome.
- 136. **snuff out** (phrasal verb) kill (in a sudden manner).
- 137. **think through** (phrasal verb) assess, contemplate, evaluate, ponder, reflect on.
- 138. **stir up** (phrasal verb) cause, produce, generate, give rise to, trigger.
- 139. **weigh down** (phrasal verb) burden, impede, depress, oppress, make difficult.

- 140. **call out** (phrasal verb) criticize someone for something (bad/incorrect) publicly and ask them to justify/explain it.
- 141. **come up** (phrasal verb) arise, present itself, occur, happen, emerge, surface.
- 142. **match up to** (phrasal verb) be equal to, be as good as.
- 143. **set aside** (phrasal verb) overrule, overturn, reverse, revoke, rule against, nullify.
- 144. **act upon** (phrasal verb) take action according to, act in accordance with.
- 145. **fall apart** (phrasal verb) disintegrate, break up, fall into pieces.
- 146. **descend into** (phrasal verb) degenerate, deteriorate, decline.
- 147. **stand up against** (phrasal verb) defy, confront, or oppose vigorously.
- 148. **keep from** (phrasal verb) keep secret, hide, conceal, not tell.
- 149. **strike down** (phrasal verb) abolish, annul, nullify (a law or regulation).
- 150. **stand out** (phrasal verb) be noticeable, be visible, be obvious.
- 151. **come after** (phrasal verb) follow.
- 152. go back (to) (phrasal verb) revert to, return.
- 153. **stand on** (phrasal verb) be careful in carrying out something.
- 154. leave out (phrasal verb) exclude, omit, miss out.
- 155. **hold back** (phrasal verb) stop, discontinue, withhold; restrict, restrain, block.
- 156. **turn in** (phrasal verb) provide something to someone (in power).
- 157. move on (phrasal verb) leave & start doing something new.
- 158. hand out (phrasal verb) give out, issue, provide.
- 159. **level against** (phrasal verb) direct (ar accusation/charge).
- 160. **show up** (phrasal verb) be conspicuous; be clearly visible.
- 161. **wind up** (phrasal verb) conclude, bring to a close, end/finish.
- 162. **ride on** (phrasal verb) depend on.
- 163. **step in** (phrasal verb) act, take action, become involved, get involved.
- 164. **try out** (phrasal verb) test, experiment (something new).
- 165. take out (phrasal verb) remove, detach, separate.
- 166. **bring down** (phrasal verb) overthrow, depose, oust, unseat, overturn, topple.
- 167. **wean away (from)** (phrasal verb) to detach, disconnect, separate someone from depending on something.
