

The Staff Selection Commission (SSC) is going to release the SSC CHSL notification 2024 on April 2, 2024, to fill vacancies through the Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2024. It is expected that the Commission will announce around 5,000 vacancies under the SSC CHSL 2024 recruitment drive. The SSC CHSL recruitment 2024 will be carried for the Group C posts for Lower Divisional Clerk (LDC)/ Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA), and Data Entry Operators (DEO) posts for various ministries, departments and offices of the Government of India and various constitutional bodies, statutory bodies and tribunals.

SSC CHSL Educational Qualification 2024

The SSC CHSL educational qualification 2024 differs post-wise. Have a look:

- For LDC/ JSA/ DEO: Candidates should clear Class 12 or possess an equivalent qualification from a recognised board or university
- For DEO (Grade A): Candidates should pass Class 12 in the Science stream with Mathematics as a subject from a recognised board or equivalent



SSC CHSL 2024 Selection Process

The <u>SSC CHSL recruitment 2024</u> comprises three stages of the selection process. Candidates will be shortlisted for SSC CHSL posts through the following stages:

- Tier 1 (Online Exam)
- Tier 2 (Online Exam + Skill/ Typing Test)
- Submission of option-cum-preference form

SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024

The SSC CHSL 2024 exam is conducted in two stages- Tier 1 and Tier 2. Have a look at the <u>SSC CHSL exam pattern 2024</u> of Tier 1 and Tier 2 below.

SSC CHSL Negative Marking 2024

There is a negative marking of **0.50 marks** for each incorrect answer in the SSC CHSL Tier 1 exam 2024 and a negative marking of **1 mark** for each wrong answer in Section I, Section II and Module-I of Section III of the CHSL Tier 2 exam.

Knowing about the SSC CHSL negative marking is essential to avoid the deduction of marks and thereby improve the overall score. This way, candidates will be able to strategize their preparation.



UP Lekhpal 2021 Selection Process

This would be for the first time that the recruitment for **Lekhpal Group C** will be made entirely based on the written test. There will not be any interviews for this recruitment.

There will be a single written exam for the UPSSSC Lekhpal 2021. Earlier there used to be a written exam followed by an interview. But with this year there will be a single exam which will comprise of a written test consisting of Multiple Choice Objective Questions (MCQ's),

The UPSSSC Lekhpal exam is of 100 marks consisting of 100 questions. The UPSSSC Lekhpal paper will have 4 sections/ subjects. The written exam will be taken on OMR Sheet. There will be 25 questions in each sections which consists of 25 marks for each section. Candidates need to attempt the every section. There will be negative marking of 1/4 of the marks of the question.
